

Credit and Grading Systems at Batman University

Traditionally the credit system used at University of Batman is a credit-hour system based on contact hours. The European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) is also being used in parallel, with 60 ECTS corresponding to the workload in an academic year for a total of 1500 hours. First-cycle studies require 240 ECTS, second-cycle studies require 120 ECTS and third-cycle studies require 240 ECTS for completion.

The transfer of credits obtained by University of Batman at partner HEIs requires a detailed Learning Agreement signed by the student, the academic advisor/departmental coordinator and the institutional coordinator. Such Learning Agreements must include details of the courses to be taken abroad and also details of the local courses of the curriculum which the student will be exempted from (i.e. the credits of which will be deemed completed) upon successful completion of courses taken abroad

Incoming students are highly encouraged to discuss the courses they intend to register to at University of Batman with the academic advisors assigned to them by their host departments well in advance of their arrival and most certainly prior to the registration period specified in the academic calendar.

1. FD, FF : Fail
2. F: not able to take the general exam due to failure or non-attendance
3. G (pass): successful in non-credit courses
4. K (fail): unsuccessful in non-credit courses

5. M: Exempt

- To be appointed as successful, second cycle students need to get at least CC, while third cycle students need to get at least CB.
